Effective December 1, 2008,

Period 1: there will be an increase of \$.10 to H&W.

Period 2: there will be an increase of \$.10 to H&W and \$.55 to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Period 3: there will be an increase of \$.10 to H&W and \$.66 to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Period 4: there will be an increase of \$.10 to H&W and \$.77 to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Period 5: there will be an increase of \$.10 to H&W and \$.94 to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

**PAY UPGRADE INFORMATION**

The ABC So-Cal Electrical program is an **8,000-hour** program. Base upgrades on the following calculations: 8,000 hours divided by 5 periods, which equals **upgrades every 1600 hours** for those apprentices working on projects bid under these 2008-2 determinations.

NOTE: According to the Division of Apprenticeship Standards, the difference between the training fee note in the DLSR Apprentice Wage Rates and the required ABC So-Cal training fee can be taken out of any of the other areas of the benefit package.
