PAY UPGRADE INFORMATION

The ABC So-Cal Electrical program is an **8,000-hour** program. Base upgrades on the following calculations: 8,000 hours divided by 10 periods, which equals **upgrades every 800 hours** for those apprentices working on projects bid under these 2008-2 determinations.
