

PAY UPGRADE INFORMATION

The ABC So-Cal Sheet Metal program is a **6,500-hour** program. Base upgrades on the following calculations: 6,500 hours divided by 10 periods, which equals upgrades every 650 hours for those apprentices working on projects bid under these 2008-2 determinations.

ABC insurance is \$3.59 per hour – Contractor to add an additional \$0.79 for the first four periods.

NOTE:

According to the Division of Apprenticeship Standards, Santa Ana Office, the difference between the training fee noted in the DLSR Apprentice Wage Rates and the required ABC So-Cal training fee can be taken out of any of the other areas of the benefit package.
