

STATE ENFORCEMENT of Title 8

January 2009

The Division of Apprenticeship Standards is currently conducting job site visits on all State Public Works projects. They are then reporting their findings to the Department of Industrial Relations. The focus is on the employment of apprentices on all State Public works area required by Title 8, section 230.1.

Title 8, section 230.1. – Employment of Apprentices on Public Works -

In short, Contractors, including the General; Prime; Specialty; or Subcontractor, **SHALL** employ **“State Registered”** apprentice(s) during the performance of public works projects.

All contractors are to follow the State Regulations by submitting the DAS-140 (Public Award Notice) and the DAS-142 (Apprentice Request form) to the appropriate apprenticeship program. Both forms are to be submitted to ABC So-Cal office within ten (10) days of being awarded the project by the Prime or Subcontractor.

Later this year, DAS will complete work on new apprenticeship dispatch regulations that will require that, if a contractor requests an apprentice and a program cannot supply one, that additional requests will have to be made from other programs qualified to train in that geographic area and trade.
