APPRENTICESHIP CLASSIFICATION: Heating, Ventilation & Air Cond. (HVAC)

HVAC.: **GUIDELINE ONLY** - All counties vary on "Total Hourly Rate" for Journeyman

The ABC So-Cal HVAC program is an eight (8) period / 8,000 hour program. The starting calculation is to be based on the **2010-2** First Shift *Journeyman's total hourly package*.

Private projects: The HVAC training fee for the apprentice(s) is a minimum of \$0.75 cents per hour as directed by the State and Federal Standards governing the program. However, if the determination denotes the Training Fee is higher than the contractor must pay the higher amount.
