#### PAY UPGRADE INFORMATION

Base upgrades on the following calculations listed above for those apprentices working on projects bid under these 2011-2 determinations. *However, the ABC So-Cal Training Contribution Requirement is \$0.75 per hour. Please increase pay to include the difference of at least \$0.75 in Training at this time for period 1. Please increase pay to include the difference of at least \$0.05 in Training at this time for periods 2 thru 5.
