Note, rates Listed above are for Zone B.

(Zone B is defined as all work in excess of 32 road miles from nearest basing point). (Basing points are the main post office in the cities of Camarillo, Oxnard, Santa Paula, Ventura and Oak View.) All workers performing work in Zone B shall receive \$5.00 per hour above the Zone A Basic hourly Rate and fringe benefit rates. See Important Notice deferring predetermined increase from 3/2/09 to 3/30/09.)

- 1) PENSION – Periods 3 thru 10 Basic Rate - \$1.00/hr will be deducted and added for Pension II (Pension = \$6.80/hr plus an additional 3% of Base Hourly Rate will be added to daily and overtime hourly rates for NEBF for all periods).
- 2) Other – Includes amounts for LMCC = \$0.15/hr (except for 1st & 2nd periods) and NEIF = additional 1% of Base Hourly Wage.
- 3) **Pre-Determined Increase March 30, 2009 (\$.90/hr to be allocated).
