Predetermined Increases

Eff. 1/31/2011 -- increase of \$0.60 (journeyman) to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Eff. 8/1/2011 -- increase of \$.65 to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Eff. 1/30/2012 -- increase of \$1.15 to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Eff. 7/30/2012 -- increase of \$1.20 to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Zone information: rates listed above are for ZONE A. (Zone B is defined as all work in excess of 32 road miles from nearest basing point. The basing point shall be the main post office in the following cities: Camarillo, Oxnard, Santa Paula, Ventura and Oak View.) All workers performing work in Zone B shall receive \$5.00 per hour above the Zone A Basic Hourly Rate.

PAY UPGRADE INFORMATION
