Footnotes:

- An amount equal to 3% of the basic hourly rate is added to the pension.
- Pension – No pension contribution for 45% and 50% apprentices indentured after 11/29/04, contribution for all other apprentices shall be their period percentage of the current annuity rate.
- Health contribution for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> period apprentices indentured after 11/29/04 shall be \$2.00 per hour.
- Training – No training contribution for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> period apprentices indentured after 11/29/04; \$0.30 training contribution for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> period apprentices indentured after 11/29/04.
- Each employer shall make the \$0.05 per hour deduction for each hour worked however no deduction for apprentices indentured after 11/29/04. Exception, all hours worked in excess of 150,000 man-hours during one calendar year and all hours worked by 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> period apprentices indentured after 11/29/04.
