**PAY UPGRADE INFORMATION**

The ABC So-Cal Electrical program is an **8,000-hour** program. Base upgrades on the following calculations: 8,000 hours divided by 5 periods, which equals **upgrades every 1600 hours** for those apprentices working on projects bid under these 2006-2 determinations.
